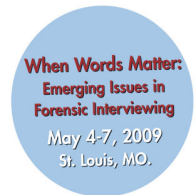

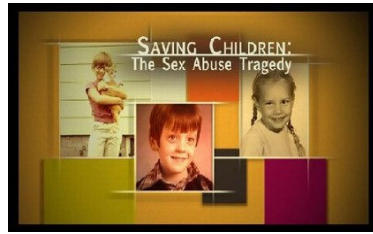

Saving Children: The Sex Abuse Tragedy is a documentary based on Victor Vieth's presentation of *Unto the Third Generation: A Call to End Child Abuse within 120 years*. Victor Vieth is the Director of the National Child Protection Training Center, the official training program of NAPSAC. Supporting Victor's presentation is the courageous testimony of five survivors.

Broken Trusts. Broken Childhoods. addresses a pervasive problem in American society. It is also about hope – hope for survivors, their families, and our children. The program includes a panel discussion held in Bloomington, Minn. in 2006 keynoted by national expert Charol Shakeshaft, Ph.D. of Hofstra University along with the stories of three survivors and the mother of a victim.

When Words Matter addresses current and emerging issues in the field of forensic interviewing. This course is designed to extend the concepts of five-day courses that teach the CornerHouse™ interviewing protocol RATAAC®.
